



LifeSavers Ministry is an intensive faith based program that strives to provide a safe place for spiritual growth and healing. It is a 6 to 12 month program with a 30 day blackout period. During the blackout there will be no contact from family or friends (mail or visits). LifeSavers Ministry will only have time and resources for people who are serious about having an addiction-free life through a relationship with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

If a person is interested in the program or having an interview, they will need to contact the ministry at 573.327.4048 for a phone interview. Following a phone interview, a face to face interview with the Director will be conducted. Applicants are not guaranteed to be accepted, but each person needs to be broken and willing to truly change their life.

LifeSavers Ministry is FREE to the residents. We only ask for \$50 to cover 2 shirts that the residents will be required to wear while out serving and group outings (the shirts will be theirs to keep).

Please note: All applicants need to be clean for a minimum of 7 days before the face to face interview. All court dates and probation appointments need to be handled/postponed for 6 months prior to face to face interview. All approved, doctor prescribed medication must have a minimum of 6 months of medications or have a family member set up to pick up and drop off approved medication to a staff/leader of LifeSavers Ministry on an approved visitation day. LifeSavers Ministry is not responsible for filling your medications!

Rules for LifeSavers program are as follows but not limited to:

Immediate Dismissal

- No drugs, alcohol, CBD, huffing or vapes
- No contraband items/medications NO EXCEPTIONS
- No cellphone, or use of another person's cell phone or electronic device that has internet capabilities at any time on or off the property during your program stay
YOU MAY NOT EVEN TALK TO ANOTHER PERSON ON SPEAKER PHONE OF ANOTHER PERSONS PHONE OR DEVICE OR READING TEXT MESSAGES. NO EXCEPTIONS
- No stealing
- No physical fighting
- No cussing at each other
- No relationships between residents
- No new relationships – coming in single, leave single (Your focus is on you and Jesus)

Additional Rules

- Smoking only outside and do not throw cigarette butts down on the ground.
- No visitors allowed on property
- Apartments and bedrooms need to be properly maintained and cleaned at all times.
- The outside grounds must be kept clean and clear of clutter and trash.
- When using the washer and dryer you must not leave your clothes unattended and follow through from washing to drying to putting away. You may not remove anyone else's laundry from washer or dryer. You cannot do laundry after 10pm. If issues arise notify staff
- Never smoke on church property or while representing the ministry unless directed by staff.
- You are required to take a shower at minimum every other day
- Take your shower items with you when you go to the shower and when you leave
- Hang up your towel and use it twice
- No lending and borrowing
- No swearing
- No phone calls or passes for the duration of the program (writing friends and loved ones is encouraged)
- No getting up and leaving class or church services without consequences. (this includes bathroom breaks – use the bathroom before service)
- No going outside your assigned apartment between the hours of 9:45pm and 5am
- No going to mailbox or stopping postman. All incoming and outgoing mail must go through staff.
- Do not go past boundaries on property set by staff.
- You will not be allowed to color your hair an unnatural hair color, and all hair dye must be approved by staff. If you come in with unnatural hair color, you will be required to dye you hair a natural color immediately.
- You must respect the boundaries of other residents (pertaining to quiet time, food, personal items, music, etc.)
- If a resident has a concern regarding another resident, please be sure to talk with that person (in love) prior to bringing it to staff.
- No secular movies, books, or music is allowed at anytime on or off the property during the program stay.
- All personal items must be kept in your room. Any item that is kept in a communal area is considered communal property. This includes, but is not limited to food, books, DVD's etc.
- Residents are assigned rooms upon entering the program. At no time are you allowed to spend the night in another resident's apartment. All residents should be inside assigned apartment by 9:45 pm.
- No smoking during chore time or any other assigned task during the day without staff approval.
- If you are dismissed from the program you will be packed up and removed from the property immediately. Whatever you leave behind will be donated and in no way will be stored for you.

LifeSavers Ministry reserves the right to dismiss a resident at any given time and without prior notice.
